Children must have trainers or plimsolls in order to take part in PE.


Homework

Reading Records



We have an exciting term planned:

Literacy	We are learning how to use descriptive features of the English language to improve our writing. We will be writing Diary entries and Newspaper reports. We are using a range of short Chinese folk tales as a stimulus for our writing.
Maths	We will be following the national curriculum, with a focus on number and arithmetic. We will be improving our fluency and recall of known number facts, as well as learning how to apply formal written methods in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
Topics	In KS2, we are learning about Ancient Civilisations. In year 6, we will focus on Ancient China and the Shang Dynasty. We will look at a range of historical sources to determine what life was like during this period of history. Later in the term, we will get to investigate the ancient civilisations of The Aztecs and The Egyptians.
ICT	'What is fake news?' will be focusing critical thinking when researching online. We will also be debating the positive and negative effects of social media, and how we can stay safe online.
Music	We will be learning how to play the Djembe Drums.
PE	We will be learning the skills and rules of football. We will also be exploring the elements of dance with Miss Patterson.
RE	We are learning about Buddhism.
Science	Our topic this term is 'Light'. This will include; Where does light come from? What is the electromagnetic spectrum and how is colour visible? How does the eye work?
